Throughout the course of an internship, participants will be asked to handle a wide variety of duties essential to the campaign. Interns will also gain experience in web site maintenance and development, social media (including Facebook and Twitter), message development, and constituent and media relations.

All candidates must be willing to put in a minimum of 10 hours per week through the summer. Each available internship has the possibility to extend through November if the student is interested. Duties are subject to change. Internships are offered on a volunteer basis; no stipend or compensation is available, though course credit may be negotiated through your academic advisor according to the policies put in place by your college or university.
